

#### Secchi Transparency

Secchi transparency measurements provide a basis for assessing current water quality, estimating trophis status and documenting water quality trends over time. It is a measure of water clarity and varies greatly among Minnesota's lakes. In most Minnesota lakes, Secchi transparency provides an indirect measure of the amount of algae in the water; however, suspended sediments (soils), or color due to either dissolved organic material (e.g. tannic acids from bogs) or calcium carbonates (marl coloring) may also limit transparency.

#### Water Quality Trends

Detecting trends in water quality over time is a primary goal for many lake programs. For the MPCA, detecting trends requires taking a minimum of 4 readings each summer for 8 to 10 years. One of the best parameters for characterizing the trophic status of a lake and trend detection is Secchi transparency. Transparency is the preferred parameter for many reasons: low cost, easily incorporated into volunteer lake monitoring programs, and it allows for the collection of a large number of samples in a given sampling perion on many different lakes.

The summer-mean transparency of a lake may vary from year to year in response to changes in: amounts of algae, watershed runoff, precipitation, and other factors. It is important to consider these factors when trying to determine if any significant long-term changes have occurred or if changes are randon in nature.

#### WHAT CAN YOU DO??

One of the ways you can protect the lake's water quality is by implementing the best management practices (BMPs) in the near shore area. These activities help control nonpoint source polution and reduce the amounts of soils and nutrients entering the lake.

### 7 Great Shoreland BMPs for Lake Protection!

- \* Septic systems should be properly maintained and currentley up to code.
- \* Use "Phosphorus Free" fertilizers as needed and  $\underline{\text{don't fertilize}}$  along the shore.
- \* Do not deposit grass clippings or leaves in the lake!
- $\dot{\ast}$  Encourage woody vegetation and tall grasses to stabilize the shoreline and prevent runoff.
- \* Always maintain natural vegetation when possible or slow shoreland runoff with gentle slope and terrace landscaping.
- \* Minimize disturbance and removal of acquatic plants as they are vital to the health of the lake.
- \* Work with local officials to ensure that the local water plan contains protective/rehabilitative management efforts for your lake.

Technical assistance in BMP (Best Management Practices) implementation may be available through local resources management agencies. Cheek with your Soil and Water Conservation District or local water planner for additional information on BMPs.


