#### No Curlyleaf Pondweed Treatment Needed

Freshwater Sciences recently surveyed the lake and found very minimal presence of curlyleaf pondweed. As a result, no treatment will be needed.

# New Tool Station at Wurm's Landing

CLCC is partnering with the Wright County Soil & Water Conservation District to install a boat cleaning tool station at Wurm's Landing, located on the SE side of Cedar. This station will feature a brush, grabber and plug wrench.

These tools will be available to help protect Cedar Lake from aquatic invasive species.

Dec '25	Propose changes for sunfish and crappie regulations.
May - Oct 26	Post signs at public access that regulations may change. Online public input accepted.
Dec '26	Final decision made.
Mar 1, '27	New regulations go into effect.

The CLCC Fish and Wildlife committee supports the DNR's recommendations and plans to survey the CLCC membership later this summer on whether they would like to be part of this regulation proposal.




