- ✓ Wright County EWM grant for \$2,275
- ✓ DNR EWM permit issued for ProcelleCOR
- ✓ Waiting on CLP permit and request to use diquat. Diquat would save us about \$17,000.
- ✓ Submitted required AIS documentation to CRWD.
- ✓ CRWD Cedar Project Fund Balances as of Feb 2019
 - PO6 CASH ~\$3,000 collect \$45,000/year
 - AIS ~\$37,000 collect \$30,000/year
