

# GOOD WEED OR BAD WEED?

## NORTHERN WATER MILFOIL

- Native
- 10 or less pairs of leaves
- 8% occurrence on Cedar



## EURASIAN WATER MILFOIL

- Non-Native
- 12 or more pairs of leaves
- 3% occurrence on Cedar



## CLASPING PONDWEED

- Native
- Submerged
- 20% occurrence on Cedar



## CURLY LEAF PONDWEED

- Non-Native
- Scalloped edges
- 6% occurrence on Cedar





### COON TAIL

- Native
- Free floating
- 35% occurrence on Cedar



### CHARA

- Native
- Musky, garlic like smell
- 48% occurrence on Cedar



### STARRY STONEWART

- **Not** found on Cedar
- Non-Native | Looks like chara in early stages
- Large very dense mats of up to six feet deep
- Spread by fragments
- Nearby lakes with infestation are Sylvia and Koronis
