Wright County Regional Watercraft Decontamination and Inspection Program Decontamination Station Opens May 10th

The Wright Regional Inspection Program is working to seek final DNR approval to begin expanded 2019 operations. At this time, an inspection is not required to enter lakes.

In the interim, random at the access inspections will be conducted at the lakes as funds allow.

Voluntary decontaminations continue to be available free of charge at the Regional Inspection Station beginning May 10th | 1300 Business Blvd (north on Annandale Blvd off HWY 55 and follow road to the end).
