## Wright County Regional Watercraft Decontamination and Inspection Program Decontamination Station Opens May 10th

The Wright Regional Inspection Program (WRIP) is working to seek final DNR approval to begin expanded 2019 operations. At this time, a Regional inspection is not required to enter lakes.

Random at the access inspections at the lakes will be conducted until approval of WRIP by the DNR.
