EMM recently provided assistance to a couple who were expecting their second child in November. Cam & Natalia had been living out of motels and their car for a year due to a series of unfortunate events. They were both physically and emotionally drained and struggling to find a stable housing solution.

Cam & Natalia were childhood sweethearts and were always close to each other's families. In 2022, Natalie had a relapse with substance abuse, which resulted in Cam's incarceration for several months. Natalia had to leave their apartment without her partner's income, and she and her daughter became homeless.

After Cam's release, they reunited and committed to improving their lives. Cam now works as a cook and attends anger management classes, while Natalia is committed to maintaining her sobriety. They are both excited about meeting their new baby and reuniting with their daughter, who is staying with her grandmother out of state.

Unfortunately, the couple had accumulated housing-related debt, making it difficult to find a long-term solution. They did not qualify for an RV park, but with the help of donors, we provided them with a two-month stay at an extended-stay hotel while we work on sorting out their finances and credit.

Despite the obstacles, Cam & Natalia remain positive about their future. They attend church and support groups regularly to help with their mental health and substance recovery. Cam is also actively searching for a more stable full-time job, while Natalia looks forward to returning to work.
