In 2015, Martha and her three children, then aged 12, 11, and 5, found themselves in a difficult situation. After being asked to leave another housing program, they faced instability, moving between the homes of friends and family.



Martha was struggling to find the right housing assistance and stability for her family. Through a connection with another client, Martha learned about Everyone Matters Ministries (EMM) and soon met with Pastor Steve. Within a week, EMM had arranged a donated trailer for her, and she moved into a park, finding the stability she desperately needed.

The mentorship and weekly check-ins provided by EMM helped Martha stay focused on her goals, offering much more than housing.

Today, Martha lives in her own place with her three children, now aged 21, 19, and 14. She continues to work in a local emergency room, and her older children are pursuing their education and future careers. Martha remains grateful to EMM for giving her family the tools to achieve lasting stability and success.

# ANGELICA

Angelica\* joined the Everyone Matters Ministries (EMM) program in 2022. Struggling to find stable housing due to the impacts of COVID-19, a back injury, and a chronic illness, Angelica was staying in a shelter following surgery when she was referred to EMM by another participant.

The program's most impactful aspect for her was the meetings with her case manager. Budgeting and saving healed her relationship with money and allowed her to stabilize financially. She also felt empowered to advocate for herself at work, resulting in a better salary.

"I am deeply thankful for the stability gained from the program and finally feel like I am out of survival mode, ready to continue to build my future."

Since graduating the program, Angelica has purchased her own RV and lives with her constant companion, Elijah (pictured below). She is also working towards a career as a paralegal and spends her free time writing fantasy novels.
