A former client of EMM told the Hawkins about the transitional housing program. Travis & Kasza reached out to the EMM team to apply.


Upon entering the program, things were hectic. 6 people in a 300 square foot RV is a huge adjustment.

"You really have to be patient with the process and humble yourself," said Travis.

Travis's case manager challenged him to explore a career that would increase his salary, but also something he truly would love doing every day.

Travis discovered a passion for welding, and started working on his certification hours. He completed his hours and is currently working towards getting his contractors license.

Kasza began plans for starting a business in administration. She received her business license while in towards launching later in 2022.



Travis remarked how their time with EMM has allowed them to take back their life and independence:

"Since the beginning of our marriage we have had to depend on family and friends for housing and financial support. I feel like we will finally be able to help others the way we have been helped ."

"Learning to budget with our money through meetings with our Case Manager was a huge shift for us. We learned that we don't have to live paycheck to paycheck."

Travis and Kazsa's family moved into a new apartment complex in Folsom in January 2022. They continue to build their credit and financial stability with a goal to buy a home in the next few years.

We can't wait to see the Hawkin's continue to reach their goals!
