Ed and Heather, (both raised and in Fair Oaks, CA,) met 16 years ago through a mutual friend. They dated for six years and married in 2015. Combined, they have 4 grown children and 4 grandchildren. Together, they have two young boys Andrew (age 11) and Daniel (age 9). Two years ago, they briefly moved to Florida and relocated back to California last August because it was so hard being far away from their adult children and grandchildren. They had no idea of the struggle they were about to face moving back during the pandemic.

From September 2020, they were staying in motels and with family until December 2020. "On December 17th, that is when God Blessed our family with EMM, at which time, we were able to move into a trailer and had a place of our own. Those few months were stressful. Wondering where we were going to stay and especially raising boys with challenging behaviors", said Ed and Heather. Daniel has autism and sensory disorder, and Andrew has ADHD.



Once they moved into their trailer and started weekly meetings with Dina, EMM Mentor, God showed them that with faith he will always provide. They both really love the way EMM's program works with weekly budgets and having accountability for their finances. "It really helped us out being able to see on paper how we were spending money", Ed said.

"The biggest blessing was that we were able to start saving money pay off debts and move into our own home within 5 months". Their goal was to move out of the trailer by July 1st, but by the grace of God they moved into their new home on May 8th!
