Started in 2003, Foothills Land Trust (FLT) protects ecologically significant lands in Foothills County southwest of Calgary primarily by working with private landowners to establish conservation easements. FLT currently protects nearly 1,650 acres of land across nine conservation easements and owns one 45-acre property outright.
