Directors Statement

I am Michelle Merring and I would love to tell you a little bit about my film- Yogurt Girl Two!

Yogurt Girl Two is a sequel to my first film **Yogurt Girl**, which was filmed over ten years ago!

With **Yogurt Girl**, I wanted to create a story that was full of magic and fun for the whole family. I loved how much my children used their creativity and imagination to make every day so special, and I wanted to capture that joy and share it with the world!

However, as my kids grew up, I saw them struggle with the transition into adulthood. The little tasks that can be overwhelming (like reading your snail mail!), the pressures of the world that seem more crushing than when they were children (bills, the endless, bills!), and the loss of their everyday enchantment. So, I thought it was time to bring back that magic!

Yogurt Girl Two was a reminder that we can still find magic in the ordinary. If we can pause a moment and breathe, then find the fun, even grown-up tasks get better. It is a rediscovering of the silly person we were as kids and recapturing that unlimited imagination. I am a long believer in the "Spoonful of Sugar can make the medicine go down", and this film shows that the "sugar" can be a shift in our perspective with a good sense of joy.

We are lucky enough to have my 10-year-old niece as part of our daily lives and it was obvious that she would be our *Yogurt Girl Jr*.! Her relationship with her older cousin (*Yogurt Girl*) is so lovely and I think we captured how even different generations can connect meaningfully and in an impactful way. It was a request of my niece that *Yogurt Girl Jr*. do more than just solve the family's problems, but do something for the community! (Yup! Little kids are amazing!) So, in *Yogurt Girl Two*, we see the yogurt siblings inspire and engage the whole community in a task that helps, well, the whole community! We are reminded that it only takes one person to start, and others will come along and join in!

I hope you enjoy the film and the everyday magic in your own life.
