The Sobriety Resource has served more than 350 individuals in 2021, 97 of whom received financial assistance. Lack of financial resources is one of the main deterrents in seeking treatment. The Sobriety Resources' program is unique, there is not another nonprofit in Georgia that has a similar mission and programming.
