Discussion was held on the Menifee contract. The board will meet with the Menifee City Council in September.

Chief Bray reminded everyone that the Service Truck equipment needs that was requested a few weeks ago should be completed by districts as soon as possible.

Charles Gangluff requested that discussion on Firefighter Incentive be tabled until next month.

Reorganization of the fire department structure was tabled.

A motion was made by Noel Duncan with a second by Misty Sutton to expend \$4,000.00 to recertify the Explorer Post. Approved

A motion was made by Misty Sutton with a second by Noel Duncan to revise the Explorer Post bylaws and make Chief Bray the executive officer of the group. Approved
