#### **AUTOMATIC AID AGREEMENT**

# FOR FIRE PROTECTION AND OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES

## FOR THE CONWAY COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT AND COMMUNITY OF PERRY

#### Automa:c Aid -

A program designed to provide and/or receive assistance from the closest available resource irrespec:ve of municipal boundaries.

#### I. Intent:

- Persons experiencing the emergency receive a seamless service through the elimina:on of ar:ficial service boundaries. The implementa:on of an automa:c aid program can enhance the level of public safety.
- The concept of automa:cally dispatch the closest available assistance could reduce the cri:cal element of :me between the commencement of a fire or rescue and the applica:on of an ex:nguishing agent to the fire and/or ini:a:on of emergency opera:ons
- Life, property, and environmental losses may be subsequently reduced and improve firefighter and public safety.
- Persons living or working in the defined poten:al areas would all stand to receive an improved level of service should an automa:c aid program be implemented.

#### II. Agreement:

For the purposes of this agreement, and automa:c aid agreement means any agreement under which:

- A. A jurisdic:on agrees to ensure the provision of an ini:al response to fires or other emergencies that may occur in a part of another jurisdic:on where a fire department in the jurisdic:on is capable of response more quickly than any fire department situated in the other jurisdic:on
- B. A jurisdic:on agrees to ensure the provision of a supplemental response to fires or other emergencies that may occur in a part of another jurisdic:on where a fire department situated in the jurisdic:on is capable of providing the quickest supplemental response to fires or other emergencies occurring in the part of the other jurisdic:on.

## III. Response Area:

For the purposes of this agreement, response area is the geographical area and/or physical loca:on in which a jurisdic:on shall provide or receive automa:c aid.

The Conway County Fire Department shall provide automa:c aid in the specified areas of the City of Perry:

• Within the City of Perry and its response area.

The City of Perry shall provide automa:c aid in the specified areas of the Conway County Fire Department:

• Within the Conway County Fire Department, the city shall provide automa:c aid to the area of District 5 response coverage.

The City of Perry and Conway County Fire Department hereby agree to automa:c aid in concept and intent, recognizing the benefit of automa:c aid to both the city of Perry and Conway County Fire Department.

Addi:onally, Perry and Conway County Fire Department accept provisions as outlined in the opera:onal procedural and response criteria set forth in this agreement.

In the event that the organiza:on providing automa:c aid is unavailable due to an exis:ng fire, rescue, or other emergency within its primary jurisdic:on or apparatus are out of service due to mechanical circumstance, the jurisdic:on providing assistance is not obligated to respond to the jurisdic:on receiving assistance.

# IV. Response Opera:ons:

For the purpose of this agreement, the response opera:ons agreement means any agreement under which:

- A. A jurisdic:on agrees to ensure the use of standard opera:on procedures (SOPs) in regards to fire and rescue training/tac:cs.
- B. A jurisdic:on agrees to ensure the use of the Unified Incident Command System during the fire and rescue incident
- c. A jurisdic:on agrees to ensure the use of a common fireground communica:on frequency.

#### V. Response Criteria:

The Conway County Fire Department:

The department shall provide one engine, one tanker, and one command vehicle as needed staffed with one officer for structure fire calls excluding automa:c alarm ac:va:ons.

The department shall provide one engine and one command vehicle staffed with one officer for motor vehicle accidents with entrapment calls, within the designated automa:c aid area.

Addi:onal resources, equipment, or personnel beyond what is specified in this agreement will require authorizing party approval.

Upon arrival, following incident size-up, the Incident Commander (IC) represen:ng the Conway County Fire Department shall have the authority to cancel responding equipment or personal responding not essen:al to con:nued opera:ons.

#### The city of Perry Fire Department:

The department shall provide one engine company and one officer for structure fire calls excluding automa:c alarm ac:va:ons, within the designated automa:c aid area.

Addi:onal resources, equipment, or personnel beyond what is specified in this agreement will require authorizing party approval.

Upon arrival, following incident size-up, the Incident Commander (IC) represen:ng the Conway County Fire Department shall have the authority to cancel equipment or personal responding not essen:al to con:nued opera:ons.

This Agreement is made and entered into this day of <u>15 August 2024</u> by and between the Conway County Fire Department and Perry Fire Department through their duly authorized Agents to provide automa:c assistance for fires and other types of emergency incidents as described under the terms of this agreement.
