

Contract for Fire Protection Services between the Conway County Administrative Fire Board and The City of Plumerville.

The city of Plumerville will receive 2 of the total revenue generated by the 10% of the cent sales tax and the 1/4 cent sales tax for providing fire protection equal to or better than the current service within the Outside Area Boundary further described below. The amount of this payment will not be less (than \$24,000.00 nor more than \$26,000.00 annually.

Boundary will originate and follow an imaginary line from the Arkansas River due North to Hervey Lane continuing north on Mt. Zion Loop to Sardis Road; from the intersection of Mt. Zion Loop and Sardis Road northwest to

include all of Hixson Road and roads originating on Hixson Road; continuing eastward to include Toney Robinson Road and all roads originating on Tolley Robinson Road; and to include all residences North to Red Oak Lane that are accessible (o Highway 92; and all roads to the South; following an imaginary line to the South East to include all areas West of the Meniffee City boundary; and continuing due South to the Arkansas River. This will include Interstate 40 East from the 112-mile marker to the 117-mile marker and Interstate 40 West from the] 12-mile marker to the 108 mile marker.

The boundary will exclude all roads originating from Bell Mtn Road

All monies paid to Plumerville will come from the 10% of the I-cent sales tax.

This contract will be for a period of one year commencing with the signature of all parties. The contract will be automatically renewed each year unless written notice is provided within 60 days of renewal by either of the parties

In the event the City of Plumerville wishes to terminate this contract, the city will be obligated to provide fire protection to this area without compensation for the remainder of the current 12-month contract. In the event that the Conway County Administrative Fire Board wishes to terminate this contract, they will (be obligated to continue compensating the City of Plumerville for the remainder of the current 12 month contract while the Conway County Fire Department provides fire protection in the area. Should both parties mutually agree to terminate this contract, the aforementioned penalties do not apply.

All monies paid to Plumerville benefit the fire department and shall be used strictly for the maintenance and operation of the fire department.
