QUALIFICATIONS/CATEGORIES

School exhibits are by students in any Yavapai County K-12 school including public, private, charter, and home schools. This is a wonderful public relations opportunity for schools to show the public what your students do. Types of creativity can include but are not limited to paint, pencil, ink, pastel, watercolor, leather, wood, metal, creative writing, poetry, working models, dioramas, photography, etc. Group projects are acceptable. Entries must be completed at school anytime since last year's fair. Work previously exhibited at the fair is not eligible.

DISPLAY RULES

Each piece of artwork should have a copy of the "School Art / Educational Exhibits

Then on the front each item should have an identification card in any color about the size of a business card should be attached to the front bottom corner of each item. **The card should identify: Name and Grade of Student their Teacher, and School.** It is encouraged for the schools to make their own cards on a computer w/ the name of the school preprinted on the cards, so they are easy to read. Each school is responsible for **A BIG SIGN** to be posted in their space indicating the name and location of their school.

All entries must be set up on, September 3rd/4th Between 10am-3pm. Each school is responsible for getting their entries to and from the fair and for putting them up and taking them down. Hanging backgrounds are the responsibility of the school. **Pre-hanging individual art on lengths of bulletin board paper works very well.** Every precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of the exhibits while at the fair. However, the Fair or the Superintendent is not responsible for loss or damage. Space is limited so it will be on a first come bases.

JUDGING & PREMIUMS/VOUCHERS

This is an **unjudged exhibit** w/ the purpose being display not competition. Most schools choose several of their best pieces to put into School Fine Arts, Department K, for judged competition and to hang the rest for display. Schools are encouraged to put their exceptionally well-done pieces into competition so those students may receive the awards and recognition they deserve.

RELEASE DATES:

All exhibits must be removed by a school official between 6pm and 7:00 pm on Sunday, September 11, 2022. **Absolutely no exhibit will be released before this time. Neither the Fair nor the Superintendent is responsible for art left after this time. Entries not claimed may be disposed of.**

***NO FREE entrance pass will be given to any student , teacher or school administrator for Open Student Department**

Instructions:

1. **Nude, obscene or violent entries will not be accepted. Superintendent and Judges reserve the right to remove entries which are considered obscene or harmful to minors as defined by the Arizona Criminal Code.**
2. All work must be original, entered by the artist and created w/in the last 2 years. Art must not have been exhibited in any previous Yavapai Fair Fine Art Exhibit
3. Maximum entries: 3 per class, 15 total per Artist, regardless of class.
4. Label each work (including unattached base or stand if applicable) w/ name, phone number, email address, title of work and medium.
5. Artwork can be on Canvas, in frame w/ No Glass, or on Foam board. All art must have a way to hang
6. Poorly presented, incomplete, broken, or extremely fragile entries will not be accepted.

RIBBON AWARDS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Class Ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Honorable mention. Class's with 5 or more entries per sub-class will be awarded and judged separately. *All 1st place class winners will compete for Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show.

Premiums Paid: 1st place \$3.00, 2nd place \$2.00 and 3rd place \$1.00, Best of Show \$10.00 Reserve Best of Show \$5.00, Best of Division \$5.00 and Reserve Best of Division \$4.00. Superintendent Award per Division \$10.00.

Judges will determine if Best of Show, Reserved Best of Show, Best of Division or Reserve Best of Show is awarded.

Consignment Sale:

All Items Entered into the Fair are eligible to be consigned. Pieces will be displayed w/ sale price during fair. Items will be sold thru the fair and the fair will keep 10% as a consignment fee. NO piece will be allowed to be taken prior to check out time. No other private sales will be allowed.
