RULES AND REGULATIONS:

We will furnish containers for all cut flowers and herbs. Cut
flowers will be watered by the department and removed
when they are unsuited to remain. House plants will be
watered (unless labeled). **ALL FLOWER ENTRIES SHOULD
HAVE FOLIAGE.**

Use general entry form. You may enter online or bring
the completed form with your entry. All entries will be

received on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 from 3pm
to 6pm.

Entries will be on display and will not be released until
Sunday, after 6pm. Neither Superintendents nor the Fair
are liable for loss or damage to exhibits left after this
time. Any entries left become the property of the Fair
and may be discarded.

Judging is done by certified Master Gardeners; all decisions
are final. Judging is closed to the public. Awards will be given
in the following classes: Garden Flowers, Roses, Herbs,
Junior, Best of Show.

Exhibits must have been grown in Yavapai County by a
Yavapai County resident.

Each person may make as many entries as desired, but
only one entry in each class.

Each exhibitor will be entitled to ONE fair entry pass
regardless of how many entries the person has.

Awards:

- **1st, 2nd, 3rd Place – Per Class Per Division**
- **Best of Show –Per Division Per Section**
