



GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

APPLICABLE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:

1. All exhibitors agree to accept these regulations and any regulations pertaining to a department when entering. Please call (928) 899-6056 if you have any questions.
2. All exhibits must conform with special regulations of the proper department. Agriculture, Horticulture, and Floriculture must be grown by the exhibitor. Any entry (except livestock) that has been previously shown at the Yavapai Fair shall be disqualified. A "professional" is anyone who sells said item from his home or business and makes 50% or more of his income from said activity. Junior" or "Youth" is a person 18 years or younger as of the first day of the fair, unless otherwise specified within the department.
3. Online Entry is available at (www.yavapaifair.com), In Addition to Online Entry we can accept entry directly at the fair office Monday – Thursday 10-5 at 840 Rodeo Dr. Prescott, AZ 86305
4. Every entry shall be entered in the name of the owner and/or the person who created the item. **ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE ARIZONA RESIDENTS** and be residents of Yavapai County. You also must have planted and grown in Yavapai County for Floriculture/Horticulture.
5. All judges will be selected by the Fair and the awards of the judges will be accepted by entrants. **JUDGES will make no award where, in their opinion, the exhibit is not worthy, regardless of number of exhibits in the Division or Class.** No exhibitor shall interfere in any way, either by making suggestions or arguing with a judge. In any violation of this rule, the exhibitor will be barred from exhibition and will forfeit premiums and entry fees. In the event if a dispute, the decision of the Fair Committee will be final.
6. All exhibitors will be expected to remove their exhibits or make arrangements for removal with the superintendent of the proper department on Sunday, of fair **AFTER 6:00 P.M.**
7. THE FAIR WILL TAKE EVERY PRECAUTION TO GIVE PROPER CARE AND PROTECTION OF EXHIBITS BUT WILL NOT ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO ANY EXHIBIT OR PERSON. Any property left over two (2) days after closing of Fair (September 13, 2022) becomes the property of the Yavapai Fair and may be disposed of.
8. Premiums will be paid by the Yavapai Fair. Unclaimed monies & Checks not cashed within 90 days of September 11, 2022 will be reinvested into next year's fair.
9. Collection/Creative Arts/Craftmanship/Needlework/Photography/Canning/Fine Arts will have online entry close on 1 Sept 2022. Drop off for those Depts and also Educational/FFA/School art will be on 3rd and 4th of Sep between 10am-3pm.
10. Fresh baked items/Floriculture/Horticulture will have online entry close 10 am 7 sept 2022. All these items will be delivered on the 7th of Sep between 3pm-6pm.
11. Online Entries are allowed 1 FREE Yavapai County Fair pass. The pass is to be used only by the exhibitor. One pass only will be issued regardless of how many entries you have.
12. Agriculture/ Horticulture/ Floriculture may be issued their 1 pass when they delivery their entries because of the sensitivity of their entries.
13. Open School **Exhibits** will **NOT** be given a free pass for students, teachers or Administers of the School
14. ***For ALL Poultry/Rabbit/Cavy exhibitors. Yavapai County Fair Superintendent will feed and water all animals. If you wish to feed your own animal(s) please let the Superintendent know. Otherwise ALL animals will be feed twice a day. First feeding between 8-10am and 4-6pm. If you are personally feeding your animal let the Superintendent know afterwards otherwise, we will feed with our food.**
