- Respect and understand we are a team and as a team member, have consideration for your fellow members and keep the interests of the Krewe at heart.
- Respect and support the choreographers and/or anyone that assists them; they really have the Krewes best interest in mind.
- Smile more than you want to.
- Begin now to work on your endurance. Aquarius and Momus are long parades.

EXPECTATIONS:

- Put forth 100% effort, energy and enthusiasm; remember, your Krewe counts on you.
- Be prepared for a minimum of 2 practices PER MONTH beginning September through January.
- Be prepared to attend I mandatory practice for Christmas and I for Mardi Gras. There will be 2 offered for Mardi Gras.
- 2 HOURS of volunteer community outreach is expected from each active member.
- Respect everyone's time. Be punctual. Practice will start on time.
- Members must learn the routines and meet attendance requirements. Failure to
 demonstrate basic competency of the choreography and/or not meet attendance will result in
 exclusion as a dancer and you will be offered to stand in as a L'Purr for parade participation.
 Practice schedule and attendance will be distributed by the Choreography Team and are
 subject to change as needed.

L'PURR's and TOM CATS (HANDLERS):

• L'Purrs and Tom Cats are the support Krewe. All Tom Cats are non-members who serve in a volunteer capacity to assist with parade logistics and overall needs of the members and support krewe. Tom Cats must wear the approved costume of black slacks and red t-shirt or polo shirt at all parades and public performances; unless otherwise stated. Any additional needs, will be communicated prior to all parades and/or public performances.
