Solo Exhibition/Group Exhibition

- All Solo Exhibition routines are limited to 2-1/2 minutes
- The music must be given to the D.J. all cued and ready, 1/2 hour before the Exhibition is scheduled to be danced.

Pro/Am Categories:

- Newcomers, (First time competitor or less than 30 hours of lessons)
- Pre-Bronze, Bronze I, Bronze II, Open Bronze
- Silver I, Silver II, Open Silver
- Gold I, Gold II, Gold Open, Gold Star
- Scholarship
- Pro/Am Juveniles/Juniors will compete in the same session as the corresponding Adult division.
- All Scholarship contestants must dance the equivalent events in single dance non-scholarship entries

Amateur Categories:

- Syllabus Bronze, Silver and Gold
- Pre-Championship
- Open Amateur
- All Amateur American Style (including Juniors) except Open Amateur, will compete in the same session as the corresponding Pro/Am Adult division.

Syllabus:

- ISTD syllabus for International Style
- NDCA Approved syllabus for American Style
- No continuity style in closed Bronze
- Silver will be restricted to the Bronze and Silver syllabus
- Gold will be restricted to syllabus
- Pre-Championship and Open categories will be unrestricted except for the use of lifts
- Those not adhering to syllabus restrictions will be warned in early rounds and disqualified in finals.

Dress Code:

- Costumes are not required in newcomers.
- Traditional costumes are optional for Pre-Bronze and Bronze I and encouraged for Bronze II and above.
- Costumes are allowed in amateur Syllabus divisions.

Rules and Regulations

In any category with fewer than 3 entries, the organizer reserves the right to merge any categories into one event.

A teacher will not be permitted to compete with one of his/her students against another of his/her students in the same style, dance, level and age category

Critique sheets and scores will be given for Exhibitions. Studios should pick up the score sheets on Sunday at the conclusion of the competition at the registration desk.

Cancellations for refund will be accepted up to two weeks after the entry deadline. A \$75 charge will be applied to all refunds and paid 30 days after event.

Cancellations taken at the event cannot be substituted with another entry. No refund or exchange will be made for such cancellations.

All payments made after the entry deadline, April 15, 2023 must be in the form of Cashier's check, money order or cash. No business or personal checks will be accepted after this date or at the competition. Make checks payable to Royal Dancesport Challenge.

Video passes will be available for purchase.
