The average Italian drinks 26 gallons of wine annually.

Let's put this into perspective. There are 16 8-ounce glasses of wine in every gallon. So, doing basic math that equates to everyone drinking 416 eight-ounce glasses of wine annually. That doesn't sound like a lot, a glass a day with a few days where you go overboard and have a full two cups of wine! Generally, you will receive four to six ounces of wine. But there are those occasions where it flows freely for a long time - like Sunday dinners with a table-full of Italians engaged in multiple conversations simultaneously.



The name "September" comes from an old Roman word, "septem," which actually means 7. 



Colorado Corn....a local favorite!

This is wonderful dish to take advantage of summers late corn crop 2 Tbsp unsalted butter 2 ¹/₂ cups fresh (about 5 ears) or organic frozen corn kernels

- 3-4 sundried tomatoes, soaked until soft, drained and chopped
- 3 Tbsp finely chopped fresh basil
- 2/3 C scallions, including green part, chopped

Salt & freshly ground pepper

In a medium skillet, heat butter over medium high heat until foam subsides. Add corn and tomatoes and cook, stirring, about 4 minutes.

Add the basil and scallion, season with salt and pepper to taste. Toss to combine. Serve warm or at room temp. Serves 4
