Accuracy in tent styles, furniture, fires, cookware and the appearance of the campsite are important aspects of the club. Please describe and explain your interest in period camping.
- 5. If you have previously been a member of RCR, please tell when and why you joined and describe the club events and activities you have been involved in. This includes attendance at meetings, help with work parties, weekend events, programs and shoots.
- 6. If you are considering membership, please explain how you intend to become involved. List the things you are interested in and what you would do to become part of the organization.
