The Laguna fire is currently estimated at 16,835 acres and is 55% contained. Fire activity for the Laguna fire is expected to remain active.

SMOKE


Light winds over the fire on Monday allowed light smoke to drift above the canyons. All forecast area locations are experiencing GOOD air quality this morning. Today, conditions are expected to be favorable for moderate fire growth, so smoke from the Laguna Fire should flow eastward with any increase in fire activity. Air quality should remain GOOD across the region.

On Wednesday, the weather forecast is to be more favorable for fire growth, so GOOD to MODERATE air quality is expected—mainly near the fire.


