FIRE

The **Laguna** fire is currently estimated at 17,275 acres and is 75% contained. Fire activity for the **Laguna** fire is expected to increase.

SMOKE

Over the fire, the weather conditions are forecast for hot, very dry, and breezy wind, which will cause parts of the fire to become more active. If it moves into unburned areas, the fire may become very active.

Air Quality Today: The forecast area is expected to have GOOD air quality during the day. MODERATE smoke levels could return tonight, especially in low areas and valleys. Places like the Rio Chama near the fire and Abiquiu Reservoir may have MODERATE air quality this evening and early morning.

Looking Ahead to Tomorrow: Conditions will likely be similar, with mostly GOOD air during the day and some smoke settling overnight in valleys near the fire.

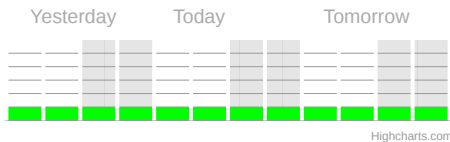
SPECIAL STATEMENT

Smoke from large wildfires to the west of us may result in visible haze across the region.

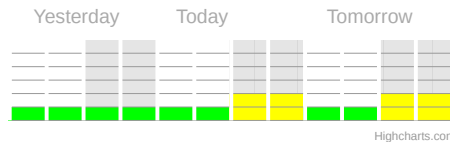
FINAL OUTLOOK

This is the final smoke outlook for this incident.

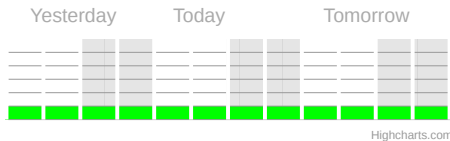
Taos Expect GOOD air quality.



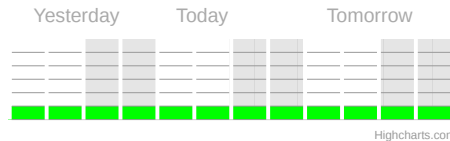
Canones GOOD conditions today with some smoke overnight.



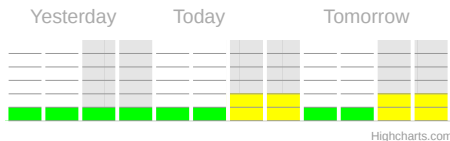
Los Alamos GOOD conditions expected!



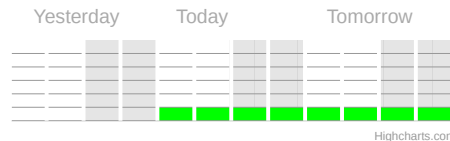
Santa Fe GOOD conditions expected.
