Entry and Payment

Payment can be completed through Pay Pal or by Credit Card – please check that you are paying the correct total.

Please check that you have included in your payment: entry fee, camping fee, yards /meal (if applicable)

Compulsory Helpers: Our event cannot run without the assistance of your helper.

- All competitors must nominate a helper 16 years and over. Each horse one helper. If a helper is listed more than once they will have two jobs. Do not nominate another rider as your helper. Jobs are 4 hours duration.
- ****There is LIMITED SELF HELP****

Withdrawals: Withdrawals, scratching prior to the closing date are to be made via Ktrials. Scratching/withdrawals after the event closing date will need a doctor or vet certificate and be received by the secretary within one week after the event. Certificate to be posted to the Secretary: PO Box 170 Dardanup 6236. You should notify the event organisers ASAP of any withdrawals.

Camping: Camping is available on grounds. \$10.00 per family. \$5 for a single. Hot showers on site.

Canteen: Canteen opens Saturday morning onwards and will include breakfast

Saturday evening meal: \$15.00 per person- meal/dessert - bookings essential

Yards: Bookings: \$20 per yard for the event. Bookings on K Trials with entries. Limited number available.

Please Note the Following:

- This event is held under the PCWA Eventing Rules 2020
- Riders entered in Pony Club classes must be current financial members of a Pony Club affiliated with the PCWA.
- Open competitors must show proof of current open rider registration (includes-Open Rider,
 Competition Participant, Adult Supporter Mounted, Club Coach Mounted, Affiliate Riding Member)
- Pony club WA members and open riders may not compete in the same class. Classes maybe offered for open riders at the Organiser's discretion.
- Insurance/Membership cards MUST be sighted when collecting numbers

Gear Check

- PCWA Gear checking rules apply for ALL CLASSES. No gear check before each phase = NO START
- Riders must provide their own number bib holder and bridle OR saddlecloth number holder
- Dress & Saddlery Refer Appendix IV in PCWA Eventing Rules 2020
- Helmets must meet standard 2021 gear checking rules
- No helmets cameras are permitted
- Medical armbands must be worn on the left arm on cross country and presented for checking when no. is collected
- All riders must wear a body protector for XC phase and riders are encouraged to wear one for the show jumping phase.

Rider & Horse Info:

- No rider under the age of 18 is to be left on grounds without an adult parent/guardian
- Riders Age: PC 105 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 13. PC 95 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 12. PC 80 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns 11. PC 65 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year the rider turns 10. PC 45 Classes: From the beginning of the calendar year the rider turns 9.
- Horses Age: A horse may compete in PC45, PC65, PC80, PC95 & PC105 competitions from the beginning of calendar year in which it turns 5 years. NOTE: The onus is on the OWNER/RIDER to provide proof of Horses Age.
- **No** stallions, colts, or rigs allowed to compete
- Any mount, which is known to kick, should wear a red ribbon in its tail.

Medical:

- Rule 28.2 Examination after a fall-medical fitness. If there is any doubt, in regards to fitness to
 compete the Technical Delegate may eliminate the rider at their discretion. A veterinarian or
 medical Officer as appropriate MUST examine all horses and riders that have a fall during training
 or competition before they either take part in another test, event or leave the competition site.
- Rule 28.3 Concussion. When a Rider has an accident that, in the reasonable opinion of attending Event Ambulance Officers, Paramedics or Doctors following proper medical assessment, results in concussion or suspected concussion, that Rider must be eliminated from the competition and is ineligible to take part in any other Competition at that event.
 - A 21day mandatory medical suspension will apply as per the Pony Club Australia Concussion Policy
