



## Coming into Spring.....

Warm your soil:

- Cover your beds with black plastic or cloches to warm the soil ready for planting.
- Tidy your growing space & plan where each crop will go.

Seedlings:

- Pricking Out: Gently separate seedlings that are overcrowded in pots to give each one space to grow.
- Potting On: Move seedlings into larger pots to allow roots to develop before they're planted out.

Tip:

Handle seedlings by their leaves, not stems, to avoid damage.

Potatoes :

- First earlies should already be in or going in now.
- Second earlies can be planted this month.
- Main crops come later, but you can prep now.
- Grow in beds or containers like pots or grow bags

Flowers & Herbs

Sow flowers seeds for companion planting and pollinators.

Edible flowers: nasturtiums, calendula, violas.

Herbs: parsley, coriander, dill

## Hardy Planting

Plant out hardy ones like broad beans, cabbages, spinach, kale & lettuce.

Succession Planting

Dont sow all at once, sow every 2 weeks
