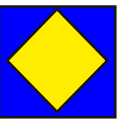
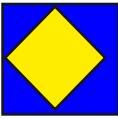
Tricky Tray Auction Donations

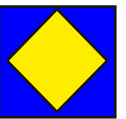
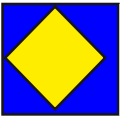
Rob Schoenen's generosity with his C8 Corvette makes an 83rd Birthday wish come true – by **Bob Messner**

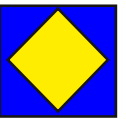
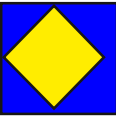

First Pennsylvania Regiment Re-enactors

more than just a car show



While many of us were still taking down holiday lights, putting away decorations, and worrying about the winter weather yet to come, members of the Skyline Drive Corvette Club were already focused on planning another unique community event. The Annual In-Vette-Tational has become “more than just a car show”, and in 2026 will again offer something a bit out of the ordinary.

The In-Vette-Tational is a unique car show you won't want to miss. The 9:30 a.m. opening ceremony will start the show with a bang, literally! Keep reading...

How many other car shows have a theme? The 46th In-Vette-Tational is “Celebrating the 250th Anniversary of our Nation's Declaration of Independence.” Ok, so that might not be a unique idea for 2026. But what other car show offers you the opportunity to see “soldiers” dressed in the uniforms of General George Washington's Pennsylvania Riflemen? Set at a historically accurate military camp, Washington's troops tell stories of America's fight for liberty through the battles of the First Pennsylvania Regiment of the Continental Line, originally known as the “Pennsylvania Rifle Regiment”. More information about this organization at www.firstpa.org.

The opening ceremony, honoring our country's veterans and active military, will feature a presentation by the First Pennsylvania Regiment and will include the firing of long guns. 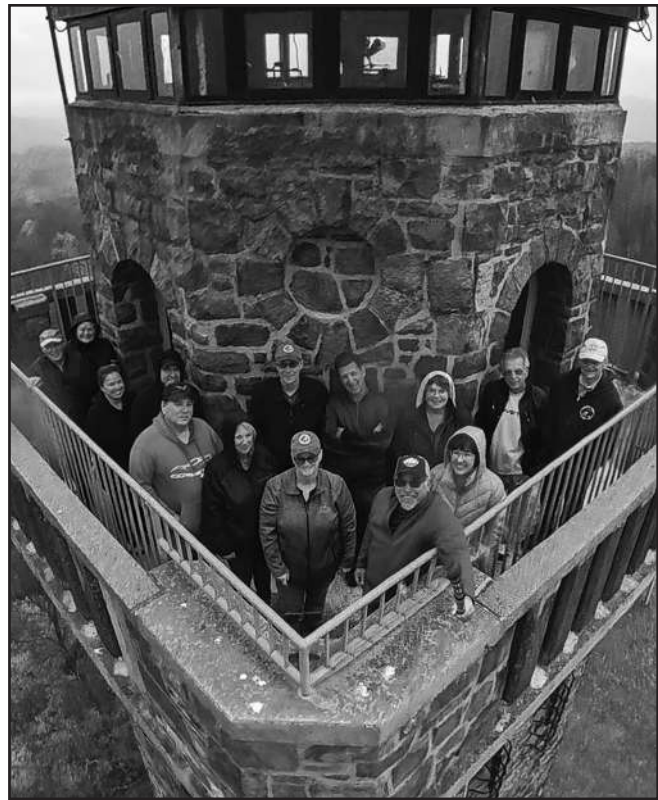
