
2024 PRODUCTION UNDERWAY

Despite this good news, there are still a couple of things that could affect Corvette enthusiasts. First, the UAW strike could still disrupt (and possibly shut down) the parts supply for our beloved C8. Also, Bowling Green assembly workers may be called to leave their jobs in support of the UAW strike

The Stingray and Z06 models are currently on the assembly line, with the highly anticipated E-Ray set to begin in approximately a month.
