
One good thing: I don't have to read about Harry and Meghan and their Royal drama as much.

AAA TO PUBLISH INVETTE ARTICLE

AAA of Reading/Berks County has again offered to advertise the In-Vette-Tational in their 'On the Go' publication. Our flyer, a few pictures they have selected from the SDC website, and the following write-up will appear in the May/June issue.

Many have seen movies or heard stories about "The Roaring Twenties", a time of social revolution in America. Prohibition led to the rise of illegal bars that helped fund large-scale gangster operations. Jazz became popular and a dance called the "Charleston" became a pop culture phenomenon among those who desired to shed the stuffy behaviors and Victorian dress of their parents' generation in order to "flap their arms, kick up their heels and let loose" – hence the term "flappers".

But while flappers were drinking bootleg booze, smoking and dancing the Charleston in underground speakeasies, the 1920's was also a decade of economic growth and widespread prosperity during which mass-produced vehicles first became commonplace in the U.S. The automotive industry's influence on other segments of the economy were widespread, jump starting industries such as steel production, highway building, motels, service stations, car dealerships, and new housing outside of the urban core. One hundred years later, the Skyline Drive Corvette Club (SDC) of Reading continues to recognize the importance of the automotive industry by "Roaring into the 20's" at the 41st Annual In-Vette-Tational to be held, rain or shine, at the Oley Fire Company Fairgrounds on Saturday, July 18, 2020.

The primary goal of the In-Vette-Tational is to raise money for the SDC Scholarship Fund which provides a \$1,000 scholarship to each of 6 students, selected from Berks County's 3 Vocational-Technical Schools, who wish to further their education in the automotive field.

The In-Vette-Tational is open to all makes and models of cars and trucks, including hot rods, muscle cars, customs and antiques. Please join us for a day of entertainment and activities, including a ceremony to honor our veterans, a performance by the Reading High School Marine ROTC Color Guard and Drill Team, a K-9 demonstration by the Berks County Sheriff Department and a Roaring 20's Exhaust Competition. And to celebrate both the old and new "20's", don't miss seeing a 1920's-era car displayed next to an all-new 2020 C8 mid-engine Corvette. Throughout the day, there will be music, raffles, great food available, a Tricky Tray Auction and lots of interesting vendor stands to peruse.


