C8 CORVETTE NEXT GENERATION REVEAL

The long-awaited C8 Next Generation Corvette Reveal is finally over!!!! It was a lot of fun! Jessie and I were also at the C7 Reveal in 2013 and we both thought GM did a 'better' job with that event, although this was good also. We were lucky to get an invite through the Corvette Museum. A bus full of mostly Corvette Board members – past and present and a few others. Plus the eBay winner that paid \$15,000 to attend with his son.

We left the Fairfield Inn around 5 pm on Thursday. The event was staged in an old WWII blimp hangar in Tustin which was a nice setting. The first two hours were held outside, much to the chagrin of ladies who wore high heels. The VIP hospitality tent for us was placed on top of fire ants, and many women with open shoes got bit!!!!!! Food was either In-N-Out Burgers, or Mexican. Drinks in the hospitality tents. Local Southern California Corvette owners provided about 100 Corvettes for a Corral in front of the hangar. Lots of mingling with Corvette engineers and Michelin, Mobil 1 technical folks. Corvette Racing had a display of the C5, C6 and C7 Corvette race cars.

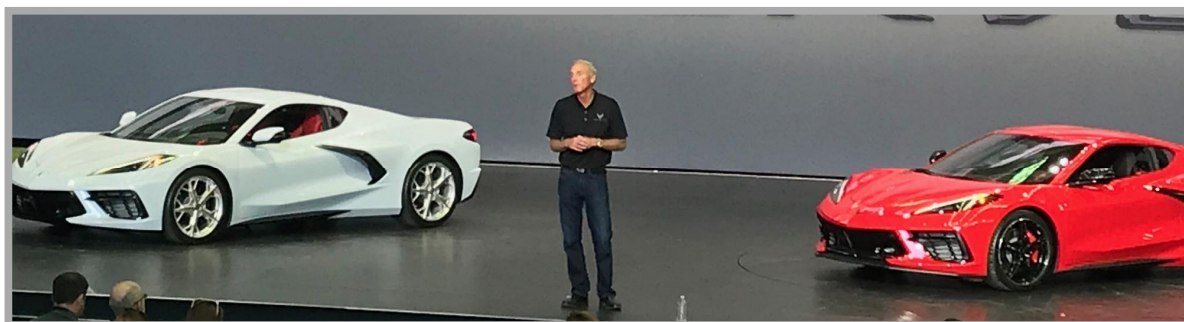
At 7 pm we were ushered into the blimp hangar where famous mid-engine concept cars were on display along with Corvettes from each Generation. We each received a commemorative coin in one of the new 12 paint colors for the C8 Corvette. Our group got to sit in the central part of the stage area. Corvette dealers and customers were on the sides. Mary Berra, CEO of GM was present and we were surprised they didn't introduce her. The opening was dramatic with the NASA Apollo launch videos and having astronauts Dr. Mae Jemison and Scott Kelly provide an introduction was awesome. Corvette Engineer Kirk Bennion said that they specifically chose the Reveal date to coincide with the Apollo 11 landing on the moon 50 years ago this week. That's why 7-18-19.

As everybody saw, it was cool when the Corvette came on-stage. Lots of great features. As Tadge and everybody from Corvette promised. The C8 Corvette does have performance and functionality at a 'reasonable' price. They are calling this a supercar and I agree. Afterwards we got to get close to the new Corvette. Lots of media folks were looking at it. It is sharp. I like the engine exposed through the rear window.

The interior is very nice, especially the driver cockpit! I got to sit in the car and it feels very comfortable. The feature that raises the front splitter/nose of the car is cool. Nice PDR feature. There is a small well in the front of the car for storage. I was amazed at the storage space behind the engine, as it could hold golf clubs and a couple duffle bags. More than I thought, and a huge concern for us enthusiasts that like to take trips in their Corvette.

Granted – not as much storage as our C6 and C7, but adequate for some trips. The Z51 package offers great performance ... 0 – 60 mph in less than 3 seconds. I think the C8 exterior looks great, definitely in the supercar class! There will be more information released over the next several months and we know that future years will offer more options and improvements!

I'm anxious to see the IMSA Corvette Racing version of the mid-engine Corvette. I've heard from my 'inside' race team source that they have over 5000 miles of testing on the C8R and it is awesome. The public debut will be held at Road Atlanta Petit Le Mans race in October and they will race the mid-engine in the 2020 season!

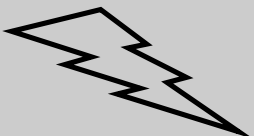

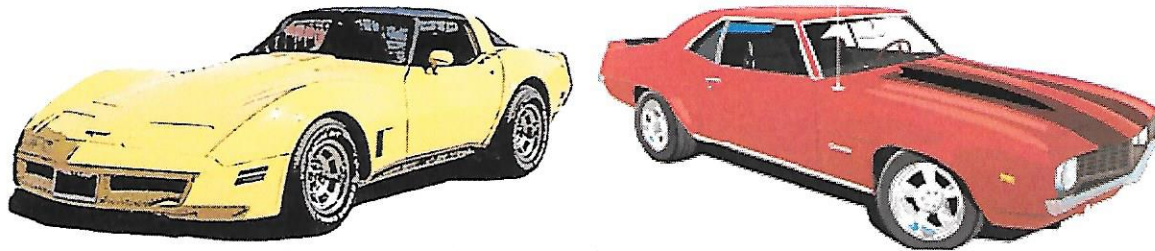
