July is a great month and most importantly the IN-VETTE-TATIONAL is here! Get your car registered or just come out to the show. It's going to be a spectacular day!

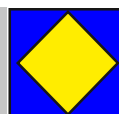
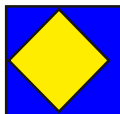
FROM THE PRESIDENT

Saturday, July 4th: Wyomissing Independence Day Parade Starting at 10:00 AM. Currently have 27 cars signed up with several carrying dignitaries.

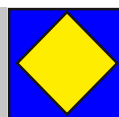
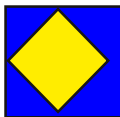

August 27 - 29th – Corvettes at Carlisle!

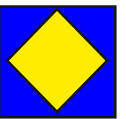
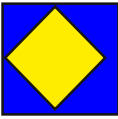

INDY RECAP

The roar of the engines, the excitement of race weekend, and unforgettable memories made the Skyline Drive Corvette Club's trip to the Indianapolis 500 one for the record books. A total of 21 members made the journey to Indianapolis to experience one of the world's greatest racing traditions together, with 10 members flying to Indianapolis while 11 others made the trip by road.

Throughout the weekend, members enjoyed a full agenda of activities including the excitement of Carb Day, the fan-favorite Wienie 500, and the famous downtown Indianapolis parade that brings the entire city to life before race day. One of the highlights was the police-escorted bus ride to the Indianapolis Motor Speedway on race morning, giving the group a true VIP-style arrival to "The Greatest Spectacle in Racing." Despite the busy schedule, there was still plenty of free time for members to explore downtown Indianapolis, sample the city's abundant dining options, and enjoy the atmosphere on their own.

Some members even walked across the street from the hotel to watch WNBA superstar Caitlin Clark play a home game with the Indiana Fever.

Members also toured the recently renovated Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum, which was loaded with racing history and an incredible collection of motorsports memorabilia. From legendary Indy 500 winning cars to exhibits honoring the greatest names in racing, the museum left a lasting impression on everyone who attended. In fact, many felt the museum alone would be worth the trip to the Speedway.

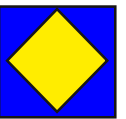
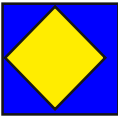
The weather forecasts seemed to change constantly throughout the trip, but somehow the group had incredible luck at just the right times. Parade day brought overcast skies that kept temperatures comfortable while everyone enjoyed the downtown festivities, and several rain showers waited until after activities had ended before moving through the area. By race day, the weather turned out nearly perfect, making for an unforgettable day at the Speedway.

Race day itself delivered history. Although the club's seating in the Penthouse Paddock area was somewhat scattered throughout different sections, every member still had an outstanding view of the action — especially the dramatic closing laps. Club members witnessed the closest finish ever in the 110th running of the Indy 500, along with a record-setting 70 lead changes that kept everyone on the edge of their seats from start to finish. The unforgettable final lap is something those in attendance will never forget.

Another breathtaking moment came during the pace laps when two UH-60M Black Hawk helicopters thundered over the Speedway and directly above the field of cars. It was one of those experiences television simply cannot capture. The sound, the vibration, and the sheer power of the helicopters echoing throughout the track created an unforgettable sensory moment that had everyone looking skyward in amazement.

The group also enjoyed outstanding dining experiences together at Weber Grill Restaurant and Commission Row, where plenty of laughs were shared around the table. Some of us will remember when Bill Flamm attempted to conquer what may have been the world's largest piece of chocolate cake. Unfortunately, the cake won the battle, forcing Bill to take the leftovers with him in a box the size of a small suitcase!

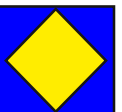
