SALVATION ARMY DUTY



Policy and procedure for the Skyline Drive Corvette Club's Annual Scholarships

Purpose of the SDC Scholarship

Skyline Drive Corvette Club recognizes the need to encourage the next generation of car enthusiasts, both mechanics and body shop technicians. Therefore, SDC promotes the automotive field as a career path by making these scholarships available to qualified students.

Students Qualifications and Requirements

A Scholarship will be given to a Senior at each Career and Technology center in Berks County who is accepted into a post-secondary educational school specializing in either Automotive Technology or Automotive Collision Repair Technology (one award in each field).

Scholarship applications will be evaluated by each applicable course instructor receiving such application. Award recommendations will be forwarded to the SDC Board of Directors for each scholarship.

Four main points of interest when considering who shall receive a scholarship will be:

- A student who has steadily progressed in his/her studies throughout their tenure at the Career and Technology Center.
- A student who has held an excellent attendance record.
- A student who has a clean disciplinary record.
- A student who shows the enthusiasm and dedication to the automotive career field.

Student Application and Award Process

Students shall fill out the application form which will be available from their advisor. Applications shall be submitted to their advisors by April 15th. Scholarships will be recommended to and awarded at the May SDC Board of Directors meeting the third Monday of May.

Scholarship recipients will be required to attend the annual July In-Vette-Tational car show to be recognized as a Skyline Drive Corvette Club scholarship winner. At this event SDC will announce the scholarships awarded to each recipient. Skyline Drive Corvette Club encourages the families and Vo-Tech instructors to attend this event. Scholarship awards will be made out to the post-secondary school in the name of the student.

Skyline Drive Corvette Club Inc. reserves the right to make amendments to this Scholarship policy. Amendments shall be approved by the Board of Directors at a duly called Board of Directors meeting with required quorum. Approved changes shall than be read at the next general membership meeting.

2009 - 2013 C6 MRC SHOCK CALIBRATION UPGRADES

These upgrades are being performed by Jim Mero. Jim was the Ride & Handling Vehicle Dynamics Engineer on the Corvette for 15 years. Jim retired after 34 years of service with General Motors in 2019.

Jim has been tuning/developing cars with Magnetic Ride Control (MRC) for almost 20 years starting in 1999 on the Cadillac STS, then the Corvette from 2004 until he retired from GM.

Jim is offering these MRC upgrades for a cost of \$325 plus tax per vehicle. VERY INTERESTING

General Motors initially confirmed that the 2020 Chevrolet Corvette Stingray would hit 60 mph in under 3 seconds back when the car was first revealed in July. Now, Chevy has added some more meat to the mid-engined coupe's impressive performance claims: the C8 Corvette will not only hit 60 mph in just 2.9 seconds, it will bag the quarter mile in 11.2 seconds at 121 mph when equipped with the company's optional Z51 package.

Impressively, the base \$59,995 (including destination) Stingray is only a tenth of a second slower to 60 mph, doing the benchmark deed in 3.0 seconds. What's more interesting is that the base car trips the lights at the end of the drag strip in the same 11.2 seconds, but at a quicker trap speed: 123 mph.

That's because, despite the fact that the \$5,000 Z51 Package includes stickier tires, an electronic limited-slip differential, a shorter final-drive ratio and has 5 extra horse-power (495 hp instead of 490), its aerodynamic addenda increases downforce, slowing the car. In other words, the Z51 package prioritizes high-performance circuit driving - cornering speed -- not necessarily straight-line velocity.

The Stingray's promised 194-mph top speed is also realized with the standard, non-Z51 model, as it has 400 fewer pounds of downforce, thanks to its less-aggressive aero package. With the Z51 package, the top track speed is 184 mph, GM confirmed. The moral of the story? If you want the most effective drag-strip Corvette right out of the box, you'll want to start with the least-expensive version. That's a refreshing change from the industry's usual "more speed = more cost" mantra.
