

Holiday greetings to all.



AMBASSADORS REPORT

Final production numbers for 2020 are in. Official count for 2020 are 20,368. The final day of production is around December 7-14. Torch red, Arctic white and black are the big 3 of colors. Least popular is Zeus Bronze at 2.69 % or 548 units. 943 Corvettes were delivered through the National Corvette Museum.

Long Beach Red and Blade Silver are discontinued for the 2021 model year. They are being replaced with Red Mist Tintcoat and Silver Flare Metallic.

Thankfully the base price remains at \$ 59,995.00 . I expect Kerbeck in Atlantic City, New Jersey to be advertising this base model in the new year.
