#### ATLANTIC CITY BUS TRIP

The 21st. annual SDC bus trip is schedule for Saturday February 12th, 2022. SDC will again be going to one of the largest classic car and Specialty car show/Auction, located indoors at the huge Atlantic City Convention Center. This will be their 48th annual event, which will include 300 automotive flea market vendors. There will be a colossal car corral with all makes and models for sale by owners. Also a large auction where you can watch live as cars cross the auction block. There will be one-of-a kind vehicles displaying for BEST OF SHOW with a prize of \$15.000, plus some exotic cars on display.

This notice is for members and friends to check and mark your calendar to arrange that you are available for the trip, traveling on a Kline's coach. It is a long way off, but to reserve a proper size bus and get admission discount tickets, we need to get a good head count. This also helps with establishing a trip price. The price per person is \$50 for members going to the convention center and \$35 for anyone just going to the casino to spend the day exercising their finger! The price this year went up \$3 to cover bus price increase and hopefully the bus driver. We need to get close to a full the bus to hold the price, which may not be a problem at this point. We have 31 people signed up from the November club meeting and the larger bus will have 52 seats available.

This event is a nice one day winter get-a-way to get you in the mood for Spring time fun. This event has grown to a 3 days, auctioning over 300 cars and trucks in 2019 (some with reserve & some w/o reserves) There is comfortable seating at the auction site with big screen TV's to watch the vehicles come to the auction area. Anyone over 21 on the bus will receive a casino token ( usually \$15 to \$20 )upon arrival at the casino terminal to cash in at the casino anytime that day. For anyone going to the convention center, it is a short walk from the casino (will be Bally's). No need to stand in line because you will already have your ticket to enter. The bus will be picking up everyone at 8:30 AM at the Breakfast Hut Restaurant and leaving for the trip home from the casino at 5:00PM. Breakfast at the restaurant will be available at 7:30 AM to 8:20, and is on your own. Please sign up for breakfast, to give the restaurant a head count for good fast service.

You can help SDC raise some funds by shopping at Redners. To participate, you need to have a "Save-A-Tape" card. Simply ask for a free card at any Redner's Market.


