
"Corvette Celebrates 70" and "Racing to the Finish Line"

The "Corvette Celebrates 70" display is currently open at the Williams-Clyne Showroom Gallery inside the American Antique Auto Museum in Hershey. On Friday evening November 18, Betsy and I along with Art and Barb Brown attended the museum's for-mal opening of the "Corvette Celebrates 70" and "Racing to the Finish Line" dis-plays. Congratulations to the Allentown Area Corvette Club for their display in the Showroom Gallery which showcases the first three generations of Corvette.

In addition to their member's Corvettes being displayed their club members have assembled an impressive collectionvintage Chevrolet, Corvette, and club memorabilia. Visiting the display is also an opportunity to begin thinking of ideas to prepare for Skyline Drive Corvette Club's future display that Ron Whitmoyer has arranged for us in the same gallery. Happening in conjunction with the Corvette display is also an new display "Racing to the Finish Line" featuring a large collection for current and vintage race cars displayed throughout the museum.
