One project is the restoration of Zora's personal 1974 Corvette. The Skywall in the Spire is amazing. Almost 360 degrees of LED ani-

mation that tells the story of 70 years of Corvette. The Motorsports Park is having their best year ever and recovered from earlier tornado damage at the facility. The NCM Insurance branch is doing extremely well. . and recently SDC acquired club liability and Directors & Officers insurance coverage at a good price.

The RC8 Museum Delivery program had their best year ever with over 2500 Corvettes delivered so far in 2023.
