SDC ONLINE STORE

The Skyline Drive Corvette Club's online store is finally open! Orders being accepted till midnight February 14.

Thanks to everyone for your patience. There were a lot of Covid-related delays in getting the store up and running, and once Rockhound Apparel reopened, they were swamped by existing customers and holiday orders. Additionally, they closed at the end of December to move to a new location, further delaying the opening of the SDC store. Rockhound Apparel is now located at 140 W. Penn Ave., Robesonia, PA 19551. Phone: 484-930-5957. Text: 484-955-9969. The office manager (our contact person) is Kendra whose email address is kendra@rockhoundapparel.com.

The way it will work (at least for now; this is still a work in progress and we may make some adjustments along the way):

The SDC online store will be open for approximately 2 weeks, 3 times a year (winter, late spring to buy warm weather items, and late summer/early fall to buy cool weather items). Prior to each re-opening, we have the option to replace items we don't care for and add new / different merchandise, including things like hats, scarves, bags, etc.)

At the end of the open 2-week ordering period, Rockhound will take the following 2 weeks to get merchandise from their vendors and complete the embroidery. Keep in mind that it could take up to a month for you to receive your purchase if your order was placed at the beginning of the open-order period. You can either pick up your order at Rockhound or opt to have it delivered for a shipping fee (cost may vary depending on the number of items in the order).

There are 2 ways to get into the store:

- 1. Go to Rockhound Apparel's website rockhoundapparel.squarespace.com
 - Click on "MARKET" at the top of the page
 - Scroll down and click on the SDC logo
- 2. Go directly to the SDC store rockhoundapparel.squarespace.com/skylinedrive

Once you are in the online store, scroll down to select an item that you might like. Most are available in sizes up to 4X for both men and women, and offer 3 different color choices. Each "style" is shown with the traditional logo (revised pagoda design) and a new "modern" logo. Size and color options are available when you click on the item.

Items with the traditional logo are several dollars more than those with the modern logo due to the embroidery for the traditional being more intricate and taking more time to complete.

Steps to place an order:

- 1. Click on the item of your choice. You will see a description of that item.
- 2. Scroll down to select the color from the drop box. (click on icons at the very bottom to see the item in available colors.)
- 3. Select your size from the drop box.
- 4. Make sure the "quantity" is correct, then click on "ADD TO CART".
- 5. When shopping is completed, click on the cart in the upper right corner, then click on "CHECKOUT".
- 6. Enter your email address, click on "CONTINUE". (you don't have to subscribe to their mailing list.)
- 7. Enter shipping information.
- 8. Select "Shipping Option" In-store pickup or Flat-rate shipping (if there is any other option shown, ignore it)
- 9. Fill in payment information
- 10. Review and complete Purchase

We strove to select a variety of styles, while recognizing that we would probably not be able to please everyone. There were some limits to styles that Rockhound was able to get from their vendors as a result of Covidrelated shutdowns. However, we look forward to input from SDC members so that merchandise selection in future stores can be improved. We hope you enjoy the store.
