There are several ways to join a zoom meeting.

Easiest way:

Click on this link:

https://us02web.zoom.us/j/88623652822?pwd=YzFuN3F0eUF2alhzbk5oVHcyRVRJUT09

or paste the link into your browser's URL

Zoom will need to install some software on your computer, say yes to that. Only takes a minute. Click on 'join with video' You will then be placed in a waiting room. When I see you are waiting I will let you in. you may need to adjust you microphone. We will be able to see you if your computer has a camera.

Next best way:

Open browser and go to zoom.us and click on 'join a meeting' then enter the Meeting ID: 886 2365 2822 and passcode

Passcode: 563565. Somewhere the new software will have to be installed. Then you'll go to the waiting room as above.

Zoom works best with google CHROME. If your computer is fairly new you should not have a problem. If your computer is a relic of bygone times you will have problems.
