
Well folks, July 17, 2021 is rapidly approaching. If you haven't already registered your Corvette now would be a good time to do it.

MEMBER PROFILE CHARLIE & JANET SCHMIDT

25 Years of Skyline Drive Rides

Our first 1987 torch red Corvette was purchased in October 1996. It was two weeks before our youngest daughter was to be married, and after two years of looking for just the right car.

We were just about to give up when Charlie read the Philadelphia Inquirer and saw the 87 Coupe with 52,000 miles. We called and met the owner in King of Prussia. We drove it and tried to act like we weren't crazy in love. We called later with a lower offer and he said this was his wife's car but yes. We knew it needed tires, an exhaust system, and some small repairs so our offer was realistic.

Besides the repairs, (the exhaust was a great reason to put on Flowmasters) we did the usual performance upgrades; chip, air foil, K&N air filter, and a few minor changes. Also this car had the Z52 handling package, the G92 performance axle ratio and BDS style wheels.

The best part of the story is that Charlie got to ride in the limo with our daughter, while I got to drive the Vette to and from the wedding, an extra thrill on a day to always remember.

Turns out our next one was also Torch Red, a 96 Coupe purchased in 2000 with 36,282 miles. We traded the 87 which then had 74,505 miles. We put C5 Z06 style wheels and a chambered exhaust on this one. In 2010 we went on our first NCM trip to Lime Rock Ct. We also did many trips with the club like the Mystery Trips.

In 2011, we made a color change when we purchased a 2006 Coupe that had 16,000 miles and traded the 96 with @78,000 miles. It is Victory Red and now has 52,000 miles. This one is stock except for K&N filters and a

Corsa exhaust and runs in the high 12's.

We took the 06 on NCM trips to the Grand Prix of Mosport 7/2011, the Twelve hours of Sebring 3/2012, the 2016 Museum in motion Marble & Glass Tour to Newport RI, and Sahlen's 6 hours of the Glen, Watkins Glen NY in 2018.

We have done many club sponsored events and trips. We realize the 87 was just the beginning of a good thing that has led to many new friends and experiences.

My initial response was, regretfully we do not have sufficient time prior to the In-Vette to find an alternate event to replace the wheelbarrow proceeds. I was prepared to donate our famous red wheelbarrow to our Tricky Tray Auction! However following ideas and encouragement from multiple SDC members, the In-Vette Committee and myself would like to regroup and try a new approach to save the Wheelbarrow. Substituting containers of alcohol with Gift Cards to local wineries, craft breweries and Pa Liquor Stores displayed on a poster in front of the wheelbarrow. Include snacks, non-alcoholic beverages, mixers, and miscellaneous items inside the wheelbarrow. Possibly include a mystery cash box!

It will not have the same Wow Factor as the actual bottles however the idea will bring some proceeds to our club's Scholarship Program.
