### **INVETTE CANCELED**

Our 2020 In-Vette-Tational scheduled for July 18 is now canceled due to Covid-19. I had remained optimistic that by now we would have improved Covid-19 conditions and could foresee with confidence it would be safe to proceed. I also established a backup plan with the Oley Fire Company to delay the In-Vette until the fall if necessary. However on May 15 I receive a phone call from Kevin Bieber on behalf of the Oley Fire Company recommending that we cancel having the 2020 In-Vette at the fairgrounds due to Covid-19 conditions and risks for us and the Fire Company. Kevin also clarified the directors of the Fairgrounds had already determined they will not re-schedule to later this year any currently scheduled events (including the In-Vette).

It is with much regret that my opinion and recommendation to the Skyline Drive Corvettes Board of Directors is that we follow the recommendations of the Fairground directors and cancel the 2020 In-Vette in regard to the safety of our community, members and families. Our BODs evaluated these recommendations and have made the difficult decision to cancel the In-Vette for the safety of everyone. Our "Roaring into the 20s" theme of our 41'st In-Vette is rescheduled for July 17, 2021.

Support the 2020 Skyline Drive Scholarship Fund with your In-Vette registration fee. Good news, the BOD has decided that SDC will proceed with our 2020 Scholarship Program to support our local youth. With the cancelation of our In-Vette we have lost those proceeds that fund the Scholarships that we are all proud to provide. Your In-Vette Committee along with the BODs requests that every member and sponsor consider donating your 2020 registration fee and if you wish, any additional amount you would normally contribute during the In-Vette for our Auction, Wheelbarrow of Cheer, etc directly to the Scholarship Program. If you have already pre-registered I will be contacting you if you would like to contribute you pre-registration fee or have it returned.

On behalf of SDC I would like to recognize along with our appreciation that our Major Sponsor, Bob Fisher Chevrolet always steps up with their support to the In-Vette and this year has made a generous contribution of \$300 to the Scholarship Fund. The In-Vette Committee will be sending cancelation notices to each of our vendors and sponsors and will also offering them the same opportunity to make a contribution if they wish.

Also, Alvernia University has cancelled all events on campus through the summer.

For the past 17 years, Vettes Cruisin' for Pets has been a great show and a fun way to raise funds for the Animal Rescue League of Berks County. Believe me, this was not an easy decision to make - but definitely the right one.
