NCM MUSEUM IN MOTION

NORTH EAST OHIO, AUGUST 7 - 11, 2022

The National Corvette Museum sponsors tours every year in various parts of the Country and overseas including the 24 Hours of Lemans. These tours are hosted by the NCM but work with local Corvette owners and Corvette Clubs who know the chosen locality well, after all it is in their backyard and that knowledge gives the attendees an insight removed from the typical tourist agenda. This year Dor and I participated in the North East Ohio tour and our home away from home was the Hampton Inn in Stow a town east of Cleveland, Ohio. This tour was a fixed base tour so there was no need to pack and unpack with ample time for leisurely breakfasts before hitting the road each day.

The NCM makes all the arrangements once the format is established with the local volunteers while the local Corvette owners provide the leadership on the road as all 25 Corvettes sallied forth each day. Of course we all had our own navigation systems since it was not always possible to keep all the Corvettes together and arriving at the destination was never a problem - but I can affirm that there are routing differences between various navigation systems. Not a problem as we all had our two-way radios for on the road communication.

The agenda was superb as we visited some well-known sites such as the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum; I guess that is something on our 'places to visit' as most of us matured in the era of Elvis and the Beatles. The size of that Museum astounded me; it is immense. But other downtown attractions all within walking distance included a tour of the retired bulk materials carrier the 600 foot long William G. Mather that was commissioned in 1924 and was only retired in the mid-1980's. In the attached photograph there is a red line along the hull that designates the waterline when the ship was fully loaded. That red line is some 20 feet lower than the no-load condition seen today as a tourist attraction.

Another site visited was the MAPS Air Museum in Green, Ohio. This Museum is an internationally known air museum and restoration facility with a focus on the aviation history of northeast, Ohio. All I can say is that even with a guided tour there was 'too much to see and too little time'. Of specific interest to me was a complete forward location hospital from the Viet Nam era. A forward facility like this would be your immediate destination after being wounded and treated by a combat medic. You would then be evacuated to a hospital such as this for determination of injuries, emergency surgery if necessary and then evacuation to a large rear support hospital. This hospital was one Viet Nam era Marine combat medic's collection. As such he had firsthand knowledge and somehow over many years collected everything that would have been in such a facility in the 1960's. Many photographs were displayed including those showing the young Marine during his tour in Nam. There were planes on display going all the way back to WWI, WWII, Korea, and Viet Nam and into the modern era. Additionally, planes from Soviet history were present such as the MIG 15, MIG 17 and more.

And there was a hidden gem on our tour and one I bet you never heard of? Even with my heritage in wood working I had never had heard of the "The Ernest Warther Museum and Gardens" located in Dover, Ohio. "Mooney" Warther was an absolute genius and is acknowledged as one of the finest woodcarvers in all of history, bar none. He received the name "Mooney" when he went to work as a herder of cows at age five after his father died leaving the widow with five children to support. "Mooney" in the Swiss dialect basically means herder which he did until age fifteen. Then he lied about his age to get a job working in a local steel mill at age fifteen. Mooney had two years of formal education and was a self-taught carver inventing and making all of his wood carving tools with steel making knowledge learned in the mills. He carved a whole series of steam locomotives, his passion, and even trains such as the funeral train for President Lincoln that took Lincoln home to Illinois after his assignation. And when his work was viewed by German craftsmen, they acknowledged Mooney as beyond belief and everything he made was in his head, not one blueprint nor measuring instrument. For a description of Mooney a tour of the Museum and his philosophy on life, go to YouTube and search for: "World's Master Carver "Mooney" Warther - Part 1: History and Tour". The video is 28 minutes long and you will be astonished. And he never sold any of his works although offered many thousands of dollars from the likes of Henry



Ford, major railroads, and even the Smithsonian Institution. Everything locomotive or train or even a replica of the steel mill Mooney worked in is still in the family, now in the fourth generation and still making commercial knives similar to those Mooney made to support his family before and after working in the mill.

I could say so much more, I have not verbalized on other locations visited, and I can say that all of our dinners were hosted by local family owned establishments with all the detail work done by the expert staff at the NCM, specifically Maci Johnson who made all the arrangements and accompanied us throughout the whole tour. Thanks Maci, you are fantastic! And a big thank you to those from the area that guided us to our destinations each day.

"Chevy Made 'Em, We Drive 'Em", that's our moto and we put another 1,400 miles on the C-8. And Dor and I added more memories both from the places visited and especially from the great Corvette drivers and passengers on the tour.
