BOB FISHER ERAY POLICY

The all new revolutionary AWD C8 from Chevy with a combined 650hp using the LT2 engine and an electric drive unit to spin the front tires. Chevy recently released the 2024 Corvette build configurator online and everyone wants to know the lead time and the price. We are here to answer as much as possible.

The Lead Time:

Chevy has not officially released how they plan to give dealerships allocation. They also have not released how many they plan to build. Our educated guess is the E-Ray will be very hard to come by and production will be limited similar to the Z06. For comparison, Bob Fisher Chevy is receiving approximately 20 C8 per model year and we only received 2 C8 Z06 so far.

The Price:

Similar to the Z06, we will have an MSRP list and an above MSRP list. At this time, we will be \$15,000 over MSRP on a minimum of the first 3 Chevy C8 E-Rays. If these vehicles are not presold, we will order the first 3 for inventory and then let the market dictate the price. After those initial orders, we will move to placing orders at MSRP.

How To Proceed:

Reach out via phone or email. Let me know which list you want to be on. A \$1,000 deposit will be needed to confirm your spot on the list. We will take an additional \$4,000 deposit when the final order is placed. This \$5,000 total will go against the total cost at the car at time of delivery.
