<u>THE LEWISVILLE CIVIC CLUB</u> COMMUNITY SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES

AMOUNT OF AWARD: (3) \$1,500 SCHOLARSHIPS

PURPOSE: The purpose of this award is to recognize a high school senior or high school graduate who has distinguished him/herself and to encourage service to the Town of Lewisville.

SELECTION: Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Involvement in activities which are similar to the purpose of the Civic Club, i.e. community leadership and volunteer service to the Lewisville Community.
- 2. Club or organization involvement.
- 3. Other school activities.
- 4. Must have a 2.5 or above grade point average.
- 5. Must be a high school senior who has been accepted to an accredited college, university, community college or vocational school.
- 6. Must be a high school senior or graduate who has been accepted to a college, university, community college or vocational school but/or has yet to start his/her academic year.
- 7. Must complete an application, preferably on-line, and, if one of the top candidates, must participate in an interview with the Lewisville Scholarship Committee.
 - * Once the application is filled on-line, print, sign and mail to the address on the application.
- 8. Financial need may be considered as a factor in considering scholarship awards.

APPLICATION PROCESS: The appropriate representative at each school will coordinate Scholarship notification and application distribution.
