President's Message

Roger's Den. (bracteosum x tannii)

The days are getting shorter. The mornings are getting cooler. That could indicate that fall is coming. It's time to try to remember all those chores I put off last winter, waiting for warmer weather. Maybe someday with this global warming I can do these chores all year round.

The good thing, or the bad thing depending on how you look at it, about indoor plants like orchids is that there is no off season and they need to be maintained year 'round. Substitute enjoyed for maintained. Watering and fertilizing need to be done regularly although the need for that can be diminished somewhat as growth slows down and the days get shorter and cooler. Orchids under lights could be different as day length may or may not be a factor. But considering that some orchids bloom on a very seasonal basis, lights should be regulated to simulate seasonal changes.

Springtime is generally regarded as the season to repot orchids. However, another repotting indicator is the beginning of new growths and especially new roots. Different orchids can show this at other seasons of the year. I find in my collection that somewhere there always seems to be plants showing that they are at a good stage for repotting and/or dividing. Sometimes instead of repotting a plant, I just cut off a lead with some accompanying pseudobulbs and pot that up, leaving the original plant in the pot as backbulbs that can be left to start new leads or disposed of as it suits.

It's time to haul off my recyclable metals, accumulations of disposable items like a satellite dish. Luckily the place I take them is only a few blocks from the orchid shop.


