

President's Message

It was great to return to our usual fire station home in February! The meeting was lively, informative, and fun, with a wealth of information shared. Here are some highlights with resource links for those trying to remember it all or who couldn't make it!

Lighting

Growing under lights using Kelly McCracken's (High Dessert Orchids) research came up several times. Kelly has cut through the lux, lumen, footcandle, wattage...hair-pulling mess of lighting and developed a system based on PPFD (PAR) that many others and I can attest, produces results. Her website is no longer active, but this close second details the system: https://herebutnot.com/light-recommendations-ppfd-par-for-orchids-and-houseplants/. Applying the research does require a light meter but with free smartphone apps for both Android (PPFD Meter) and iPhone (Photone), getting started does not require an investment in a meter. AOS has also curated an excellent presentation by Kelly entitled "Evolution of LED Lighting and Orchids," which we can make part of a future meeting if there is interest.

Magnesium and Calcium

Matt shared how he turned a newly purchased, mounted orchid with weak, yellowed foliage into a thriving, blooming beauty by patiently correcting a magnesium deficiency with Epsom salt solution misting. Amal has since found an excellent article by Sue Bottom of the St. Augustine Orchid Society detailing supplementation with magnesium and its partner in orchid health, calcium. Automated Watering for Windowsill Growers

I have gotten several questions about the drip irrigation system I used to automate the watering of my orchids. There are many options, some even app-controlled, but the Moistenland system below won out for me for its simplicity, reliability, and ability to water for very short intervals. If you are eyeing automation for a trip, start early. Setup requires a hands-on "test and tune" period of a few weeks, but weekly checks seem to suffice once lined out. I am happy to share my setup and troubleshooting steps with anyone who wants to try it.

Collection Cataloging

Jojo shared an excellent orchid collection inventory program that allows you to record details of your plants, including photos, watering schedules, and their development over time. There is a PC and Mac version available (\$19.99), although, at present, the mobile version (\$7.99) is only available for iPhone/iPad/iPod touch. A "lite version" allows you to trial the software free for three orchids, three watering schedules, and log three entries. If you are struggling with an Excel sheet and a disconnected folder of photos, this program may be for you.






