Happy New Year! We're definitely starting the year with weather that only a penguin could love, but on the bright side, the deep freeze will be over just in time for our meeting on Saturday! Fortunately, our January meeting doesn't conflict with hazmat training this year, so we'll be able to meet at CSFS #14 throughout 2025.

If cabin fever is setting in, the Denver Botanic Gardens may have the cure. Their "Orchid Showcase" is in full swing, featuring hundreds of blooming orchids, including those from the Garden's collection. The Showcase runs now through Monday, February 17th, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Additionally, "Orchid Day," celebrating all things orchid, will be held on Friday, February 7th, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., offering family-friendly educational activities and hands-on fun throughout the Gardens. Both events are included with general admission. A special thanks to Jean for the heads-up to ensure we didn't miss these events!

The Denver Orchid Society does not meet in person in February but excitedly has secured Fred Clarke of Sunset Valley Orchids to present via Zoom. He will be giving his "Becoming an 80 Percentile Grower" talk, and the DOS has generously arranged for all Colorado orchid societies to join them!

Fred's orchid expertise spans developing *Cattleya* hybrids, as well as *Paphiopedilum* and Aussie *Dendrobium* hybrids. His groundbreaking work with *Catasetum* intergenerics led to the creation of the grex, *Fredclarkeara After Dark*, known for the "blackest flower ever witnessed," this grex has received over 100 awards, including nine FCCs and 30 AMs. Fred is also an Accredited Judge with the Pacific South Judging Region, and plants in his collection have earned numerous awards from the American Orchid Society.

In his presentation, "*Becoming an 80 Percentile Grower*," Fred will draw on his 42 years of orchid-growing experience to explore how and why orchids grow as they do and share fundamental and advanced techniques for growing them with success. This presentation has sparked the interest of many CSOS members, and we are very grateful to the DOS for inviting us to be their guest for this excellent opportunity to grow our skills! Watch your email for the Zoom link in the coming weeks. If you don't Zoom, consider rounding up a Zoom buddy who does and watching the presentation together. Thank you again, DOS!

Our December meeting boasted an incredible number and variety of blooming orchids. I can't wait to see what you all bring in January!

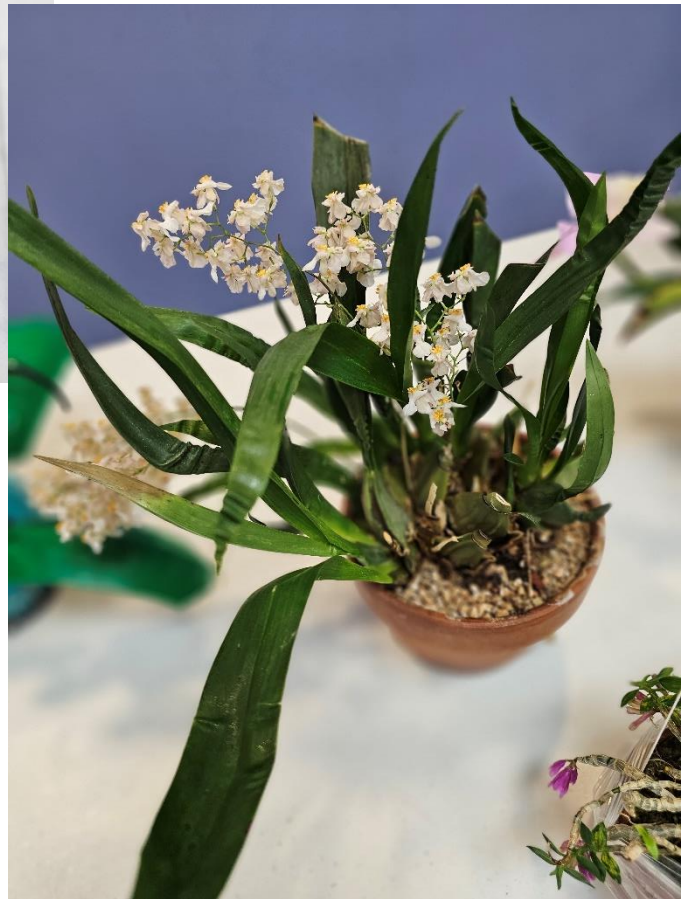

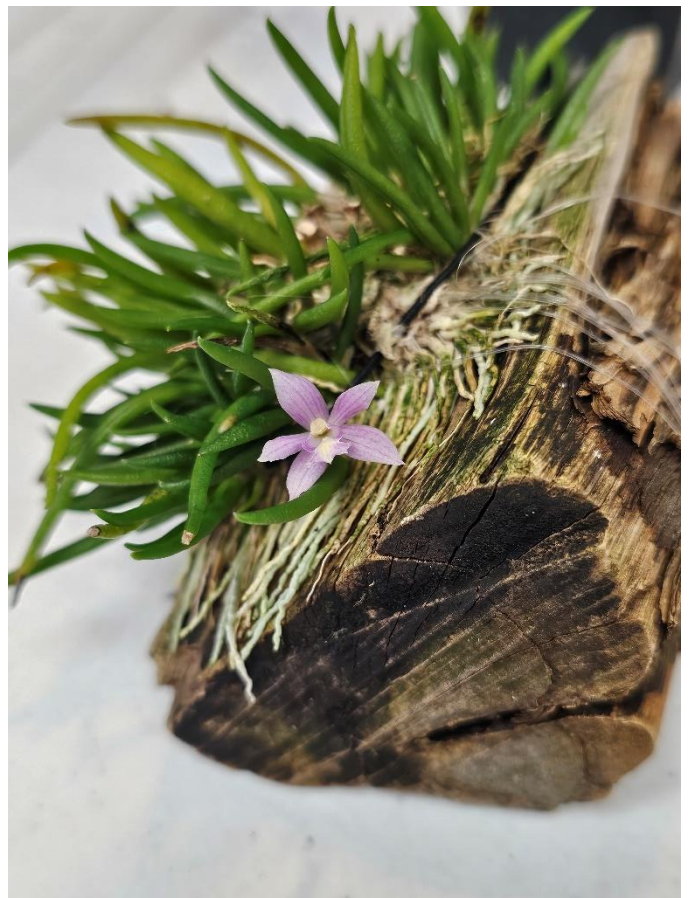

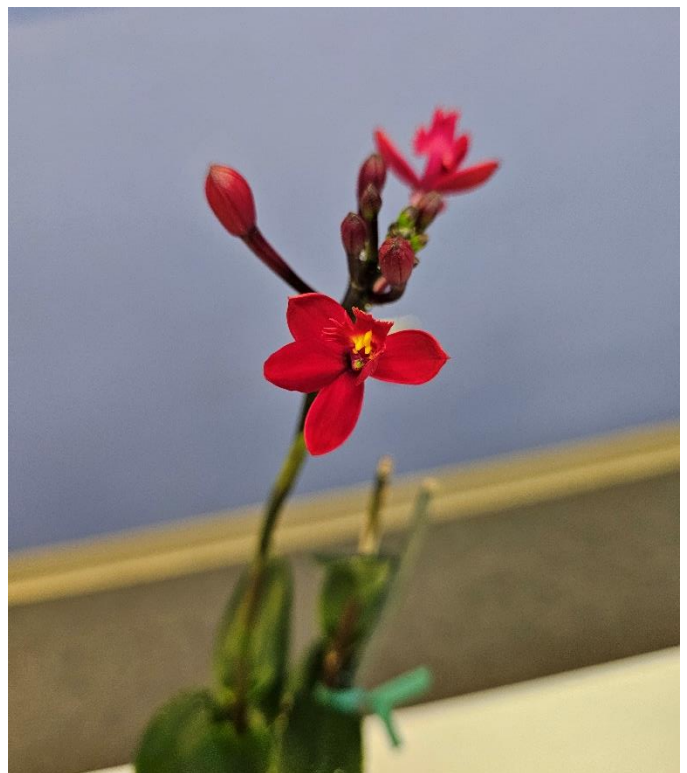
