Council would like to take this opportunity to thank the congregation for participating in the discernment process to this point. A special thank you to the Strategic Planning Team, Facilities Team, and Community Assessment Team who have worked hard over the past several months to gather information enabling us to establish a new vision, goals, and objectives.

Unfortunately, at this time, despite the hard work of our leadership teams, we are unable to make a recommendation for the best use of our facilities. Therefore, there will be no congregational meeting on June 29th.

As a council, we are struggling to see a clear path forward. It has been a difficult process, and we have spent many hours and meetings to try to discern God's will for us. We feel that more information is needed. To move the process forward, we have decided to hire a coach from the ELCA Coaching Network who has experience working with church mergers. We will also appoint a task force made up of congregation members. This task force will research the questions that have emerged from the process, giving us the ability to further assess the strengths and weaknesses of each facility for the purpose of accomplishing our mission.

We will keep the congregation updated as we move forward through monthly updates in the newsletter. A formal presentation will be given at the congregational meeting in November.

We appreciate the support and prayers the congregation has given us. We ask that you continue to support us and keep us in your prayers as we discern a path forward. Together we will find a way forward that honors God's will for our church.



#### Strategic Plan Group, Goal #3, Bridging the Generation Gap

Milton Lutheran Church is excited to launch Swim, Gym, and Him — a new monthly partnership with the Milton YMCA starting this August. These evenings are designed to help bridge the youth gap at MLC by offering a welcoming, active, and faith-centered environment for youth ages 6–12.

Held at the Milton YMCA, each event will feature a variety of fun activities including swimming, basketball, volleyball, pickleball, esports, and more — all organized and led by MLC staff and volunteers. In addition to the games and fellowship, each night will include a short Bible study or faith-based conversation, with occasional guest talks from Pastor Gary or other church leaders.

This is a space where youth can explore their faith freely, connect with others, and feel supported — no prior knowledge or experience needed. We're meeting them where they are, both spiritually and socially. Stay tuned for final details on dates, times, and pricing, which will be announced soon. This pilot program was initiated by the members of the Strategic Plan group striving to bridge the Generation Gap here at MLC.

Our pet pantry is the first Sunday of the month from 11:30am-12:30pm held in conjunction with our Self-Care Sanctuary. Our next one is July 6th.








Please consider signing up on the bulletin board for an item to donate for our day camp crafts!
