Hiking Group

The MLC Hiking Group will have their next hike on Black Friday, 11/28/25 (the day before rifle deer season starts). We will be traveling to Hickory Run State Part to hike two easy trails. First is the 2.2 mile Shades of Death Trail. Don't let the name spook you. It is a very scenic hike along a stream and not hard at all. After this hike we will drive further into the park to hike 1.2 miles to Hawk Falls. After the hikes we will have refreshments at Tavern On The Hill in White Haven. We will leave from the church parking lot at Noon. Or you can meet us at the Shades of Death parking lot about 1 pm. Follow I-80 E to Exit 274, PA-534 toward Hickory Run State Par for 5.1 miles to the parking lot. Take a day pack with water and maybe a trail snack. There should be no bugs, but you are welcome to use bug/tick spray just in case. Take trekking poles if you use them.

On Friday 10/31/25 four of us in the hiking group hiked the Upper Part of the Falls Trail at Ricket's Glenn. There were heavy rains the day before so we were treated to spectacular roaring falls! After our hike we had great refreshments at the Ricket's Glenn Hotel.

On Sunday 11/16/25 three of us hiked several of the trails at Ryder Park near Warrensville. Several hikers backed-out due to strong winds, but most of our hiking was in the woods with very little wind. It was actually a very enjoyable afternoon for a hike! 
Remember that any of your contributions are matched by the church, so you have effectively DOUBLED the contribution to the campaign.
