


On July 17th eleven participants graduated from the 19 week program at Getting Ahead in the Valley.

Dear Congregation,

First and foremost, I want to thank you all for your steadfast support, love, and kindness you have showed me throughout my life as a member of Milton Lutheran Church. I am writing to update you all that I have been selected to serve as Young Adult in Global Mission (YAGM) for

the ELCA. In early September, I will depart for Argentina/ Uruguay and serve, live, and walk with my host community for 10 to 11 months. In June, I will find out more details on where exactly I will be living and what my service placement is. I am incredibly excited to have this opportunity to live my faith and thank you all for playing such a critical role in my faith journey and helping me to reach this point.

In case you are not familiar, YAGM is an international year of service for young adults to support the ministries and projects of the ELCA's global companions. As a volunteer, I will embark on a journey of self-reflection to consider my own identity, God's work in the world, and my place within it all. In the spirit of accompaniment, volunteers walk alongside global companions in a manner that practices mutuality, interdependence, and solidarity. Areas of service include, but are not limited to, health and human rights, education, environmental justice, professional support, and congregational ministry. In our placements, my fellow volunteers and I will confront issues of wealth and poverty, racial privilege, gender privilege, economic disparity, and globalization, all through the lens of faith.

When I applied for Young Adults in Global mission, I was initially hoping to use it as a backup plan in case my delayed Peace Corps service never came to fruition. But, after learning more about the program and moving through the interview process, it became my first choice. As I am pursuing a career in international development and humanitarian assistance, I have always planned to do some type of volunteer work internationally. It is a key opportunity that allows one to understand different cultural contexts and gain more experience serving others, particularly the marginalized groups that development aid and organizations aim to help. However, in the YAGM application process, I came to realize it's my faith that draws me to this career in the first place. It is through my work that I can live my faith. For me, YAGM provides a fourfold opportunity to learn about myself, grow in my faith, deepen my understanding of Latin America, and gain the necessary experience to better serve others and observe how development works at the community level.

My service year in Argentina/Uruguay, like the time I spent in Liberia, will shape my life in infinite ways. I am so grateful for the way it intersects key areas of my life while also providing me the opportunity to learn what it truly means to walk in community with Christ. As part of accepting this call, I am asked to raise at least \$5,000. If you are able, I kindly ask you consider supporting my fundraising efforts.
